"I saw his picture (on the Internet), and it seemed like he had a little bit of a double chin," she explains. "Not a big deal. But in person ... his neck was abnormally huge. It was just all chin."

The pair parted, and he's been free to lure in other ladies, until Robyn came across WhatDoYouKnowAboutRomeo.com, a new forum for gals to dish on dates arranged through romance sites.

As if the Internet isn't treacherous enough in this brave new dating world, now there's a way to play private eye on an unwitting dude.

Wanting to warn other women about her experience, Robyn posted a review. "He really is a nice guy but seriously has NO NECK," she wrote. "I'm not one to base things completely on looks but his pic was slightly deceiving. Plus he got up to pee about five times in the two-hour span of dinner. If you can get over the neck issue, he'd be a keeper."

The site has been up for less than two months, but 200 New York City singles have already logged on.

Manhattanites Elaine Schweppe and Jennifer Piacenti created WhatDoYouKnowAboutRomeo after Schweppe's experience with online dating.

"I went out with somebody who was 3 inches shorter than his profile said," Schweppe says. "It struck me that he's been on Match.com for four years. So there are all these women who already know about this guy. Wouldn't it be great if there was a place where we could share information _ both good and bad?"

She launched the date-dishing site to take the mystery out of meeting men you've chatted with only onscreen.

But WhatDoYouKnowAboutRomeo isn't strictly for dumping on dudes. A third of the reviews are positive.

"We read every review and hand-approve them so you can't use contact info, last names," Piacenti says.

Lots of ladies gave raves to guys they thought were great but just didn't connect with.

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
